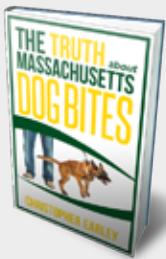

Helping People Achieve Their **AMERICAN DREAMS**

When I entered law school I knew immediately that I wanted to practice immigration law. I was originally inspired by my grandparents' stories and later, by the many Mexican and Central American cooks I worked with in the restaurant industry to help pay my way through college and law school. I see my own family, my own grandparents, cousins, aunts, and uncles in my current clients.

Many, if not most, of my clients come from the so called 'Northern Triangle'. This refers to the Central American nations of Guatemala, Honduras and El Salvador. For reasons too numerous to go into here, life can be very difficult in this area. Government corruption is rampant, criminal organizations act with impunity and poverty is widespread. It's a difficult place to thrive or even survive.

Many make the difficult choice to travel north, through Mexico and into the United States, risking life, limb, family separation and even worse just to get here. This brings to mind a young teenage female client of mine who came to the U.S. from a small Mayan village in Guatemala. She made it here

with no parental support and very little ability to speak English or Spanish. She now speaks both fluently, has graduated high school and earned a college scholarship. She was even invited to

speak at Boston City Hall about her journey. While not every newcomer is as accomplished as that young lady, the majority work hard, raise their children, pay their taxes and contribute to the cultural landscape of Massachusetts.

We work with asylum seekers, unaccompanied juveniles, and immigrants who have lived here many years but have never found a way to legalize their status. 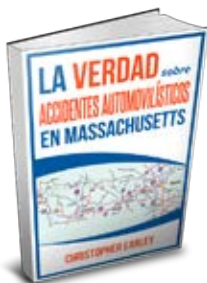

RORY'S RECIPES: Cookies for Dad!

For all the dads out there, here is an awesome chocolate chip cookie recipe from Tate's Bake Shop! We love a thin crispy cookie in our house!



Happy Father's Day from the Earley family!

INGREDIENTS:

- 2 cups unbleached all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 cup (2 sticks) lightly salted butter, at room temperature
- ¾ cup granulated sugar
- ¾ cup firmly packed dark brown sugar
- 1 teaspoon water
- 1 teaspoon pure vanilla extract
- 2 large eggs, beaten
- 2 cups semisweet chocolate chips

DIRECTIONS:

- 1 Preheat the oven to 350°F.
- 2 Whisk the flour, baking soda, and salt together in a bowl.
- 3 In another large bowl, mix the butter with a wooden spoon to lighten it a bit, then mix in the sugars.
- 4 Add the water, vanilla, and eggs to the butter mixture.
- 5 Stir in the flour mixture until just combined, then fold in the chocolate chips.
- 6 Using 2 soup spoons, drop the cookies 2 inches apart onto 2 nonstick or greased cookie sheets.
- 7 Bake for 8 minutes, rotating the sheets after 4 minutes.
- 8 Remove the cookies to a wire rack to cool and repeat the process with the rest of the batter.
