RORY'S RECIPES: Ina Garten's Salmon with Green Herbs



This very easy and healthy salmon recipe is quick to prepare and always wows a crowd (or just my husband).

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 large (2 to 2 1/2 pound) salmon fillet, bones and skin removed
- Kosher salt and freshly ground black pepper
- 1/4 cup olive oil
- 2 tablespoons of freshly squeezed lemon juice
- 5 scallions minced
- 1/2 cup minced fresh dill
- 1/2 cup minced fresh parsley
- 1/4 cup dry white wine

DIRECTIONS:

- 1 Place the salmon fillet in a nonreactive roasting dish and season generously with salt and pepper. Whisk olive oil and lemon juice together and drizzle the mixture evenly over the salmon. Let it stand at room temperature to marinate for 15 minutes.
- 2 Preheat oven to 425 degrees.
- 3 In a bowl, stir together the scallions, dill, and parsley. Scatter the herb mixture over the salmon fillet, turning it so that both sides become generously coated with the green herbs. Pour the wine over and around the fish fillet.
- 4 Roast the salmon for 10 to 12 minutes, until almost cooked in the center at the thickest part. Remove from the oven and cover tightly with aluminum foil.
- 5 Allow to rest for 10 minutes. Cut the salmon across into serving pieces and serve hot with lemon wedges. Enjoy!

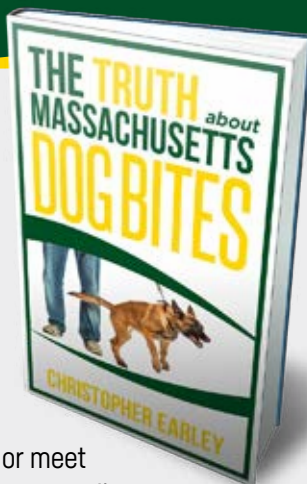

WORKERS' COMPENSATION FAQ'S

Lawyer Chris Earley Answers Common Questions
about Workers' Compensation

Q: What is workers' compensation?

A: Workers' compensation provides injured workers with wage replacement and medical benefit coverage in the event of an accident at work. This is a no-fault system which means even if you were completely, or partially responsible for causing the accident, you can still collect these benefits.

Q: Who can collect these benefits?

A: These benefits are available to all employees (full and part-time), but not to independent contractors. Temporary employees are also eligible. Non-citizens are eligible as well. And, even if one is paid in cash, workers' compensation is still available. Even if an employee is injured on the first day of the job, he/she is still protected by workers' compensation law.

Q: What benefits are available?

A: Available benefits include wage replacement, medical benefits, payment for scarring and disfigurement, as well as death benefits. These are tax-free benefits that neither the state or federal government taxes.

The fact that these benefits are available however does not mean they will be freely given. Insurance companies routinely deny legitimate claims. They like to keep their money, rather than pay it out to deserving workers who have rightful claims to workers' comp benefits.

When they do deny claims, it is important to have legal representation on your side. Our office can help you file the necessary paperwork with the Department of Industrial Accidents. ■
